Roller derby is a real sport, with real contact. Unlike the roller derby of the 1970s, today's roller derby is not a theatrical performance, but a true showing of strong, athletic women battling it out on the flat track. All of our skaters train hard to get in shape. OVRG follows the rules set forth by WFTDA, the sport's international governing body. In



addition to training several times a week for several hours at a time, OVRG participates in fundraising and volunteering for our community. At our home games we hold a 50/50 raffle with proceeds going to a local charity. This past season the league has donated to local women's shelters, food banks, animal shelters, and many other local community outreach programs.



Roller Derby Outreach

Roller Derby is fast growing, highly visible, and full contact. Fans feel very passionate about flat track roller derby, and our fans defy stereotypes. From sports fans, to punk rockers, to soccer moms, our advertising reaches them all.
